

### SAINT OF THE WEEK St. Francis Xavier – Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020

He was a companion of Ignatius of Loyola and one of the first seven Jesuits who took vows of poverty and chastity. He led an extensive mission into Asia and was influential in evangelization work. He also was the first Christian missionary to venture into Japan, struggling to learn the local languages and in the face of opposition, he had less success than he had enjoyed in India. Xavier was about to extend his missionary preaching to China when he died. He was beatified by Pope Paul V on 25 October 1619 and canonized by Pope Gregory XV on 12 March 1622. Known
