Most of the commandments can be summed up in these words, "Love your neighbour as yourself." When dealing with issues of conflict or disagreement, first try in private, then with witnesses, and finally in front of an assembly—providing evidence of injustice or wrongdoing. If still no resolution, we must turn away and move on, knowing that we have done everything humanly possible.


