Jesus uses a parable to teach a positive, even shocking lesson on the prudent use of wealth. Christian disciples should display caution in their use of possessions, especially in view of the more important crisis that faces them—namely, the nature of the coming kingdom of God. Such prudence is an effective test of their ability to handle true, heavenly riches. It is also an effective test of their allegiance to God.


