It is possible to be wealthy and to enjoy God's favour—Abraham, David, and Solomon serve as examples. The question is not whether we have money, but whether we love money (see 1 Timothy 6:10)—whether we share God's concern for the poor and vulnerable—whether we are too preoccupied with personal concerns to notice the Lazarus in our midst?


