Our task is the faithful teaching of the truth of the Gospel, even though some will be offended and refuse it. The message is based on the person of Jesus, the Messiah, the Son of the Living God, and on His work, the work of redemption.



## OVER 3.5 MILLION DOLLARS RAISED FOR FAMINE RELIEF CAMPAIGN

On 7 June 2017 the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops coordinated and launched an ecumenical and interfaith appeal in response to the famines in South Sudan and the extreme food shortages in Yemen, northeast Nigeria and Somalia. The total amount raised is \$3,710,880, of which \$2,042,625 is eligible for the Federal Government's match campaign. This means that the Catholic response represents 17.67% of the overall \$21.3 million raised between March 17 and June 30.
