Jesus set for his followers a three-step procedure for reconciling differences. Reconciling differences is one of the most challenging jobs of parenthood. When our children see us calmly, but firmly, address someone, naming the infraction and saying how the action made us feel, they learn that there are other ways besides hostile confrontation to work out differences.


