Jesus may have chosen the word "hate" to show us that this is how a mother or father will perceive the actions of a child who chooses the Lord above them. They will see it as disloyal. But we must be okay with being seen as "hating." After all, our unbelieving relatives are part of the world, and Jesus said, "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first" (John 15:18)


