Sometimes we can hear the word of God but fail to put it into practice; we receive the Eucharist but are not nourished by it. So take time with Jesus and ask him to touch the ears of our heart and loosen our tongues so that we may hear his life-giving words and speak clearly about how God is working in our lives.


