PASTOR'S DESK**APRIL 14, 2024 – THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER****Stewardship Life**

“Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, ‘Peace be with you.’ But they were startled and frightened ...” - LUKE 24:36-37

Throughout the day we have many opportunities to “see the face of Jesus” in others and to “be the face of Jesus” to others. Do we take that opportunity to provide “peace” to those we encounter or are we afraid of what others will think of us and do nothing? Pray for the strength and courage to live a “God-centered” life of **Stewardship** and not a “self-centered” life.

Easter Resurrection Stories

Do you have one to share? We have 50 days of Easter to get it right. There are many post/resurrection Gospel accounts of his rising and the reality of who we are as Christians. Our Easter faith brings us together, the Gospel is proclaimed, our sins are forgiven because of Easter.

Pope Francis shares an embrace with an Israeli and a Palestinian man, each of whom lost a daughter during the war and saying to them *“look beyond the enmity of war”*. The Pope recently discussed patience (Wed. Audience) and knowing how to bear difficulties. He explained how both of these men who lost their daughters are now friends. “They do not look at the enmity of war,” he said. “They look to the friendship of two men who care about each other and have experienced the same crucifixion.” The Holy Father has repeatedly called for a ceasefire in the Gaza Strip to facilitate access to humanitarian aid, for negotiations to end the war, and for the release of the hostages.
