From the Pastor's Desk

Fourth Sunday of Easter (C), April 17, 2016 "I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me'' (Jn 10:14) The imagery of Jesus as lamb has profound theological and sacrificial implications, especially in Johannine literature, which presents Jesus as the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. But the imagery of the Lamb offers us another image: the lamb is one of us, the sheep. In a homily in 2013 Pope Francis asked that priests "be shepherds with the smell of sheep." Jesus literally embodied this principle in the Incarnation by becoming the shepherd who joins the flock. Having grown up on the farm I know the smell of sheep, the cattle, and all those smelly places where farm animals and chickens stay and rest from the elements of weather etc. Further the animal on the farm knows the call, the voice of the farmer... I can attest from my own father calling the cattle in... knowing there is food to comfort them! There is something about the voice of the Shepherd and/or the farmer!

VOCATION SUNDAY IS TODAY!

(Fr Frank) When was the last time a priest was given from this parish? Today on this Good Shepherd Sunday, fourth Sunday of Easter we pray and reflect upon the importance of vocations. As I told a packed church here last Sunday for "first communion" it all begins at Baptism (pointing to the baptismal font) Our children who receiving Eucharist for the first time are entering the journey with their Good Shepherd who hears His voice! Vocations come from families with lively faith and prayerful life! I was blessed to have loving parents who were very active with the church and befriended many priests who came and went from their church at St. Michael's, Corkery. They lived for/with the Church. We have become mission territory here in this Diocese when we rely heavily on priests from Africa and Asia and priests from Religious communities. We have many young men and women who come here to worship let us pray for their vocation and discernment. Let us pray for our seminarian, Jonathan Kelly as he has two more years of study before ordination!
