From the Pastor's Desk

Sunday (April 3): "Unless I see - I will not believe" Would those words be true today? Is it possible for many baptized Christians to no longer believe? Have heavy doubts as did **Thomas in the upper room?** The Risen Lord Jesus revealed the glory of his resurrection to his disciples gradually and over a period of time. Even after the apostles saw the empty tomb and heard the reports of Jesus' appearance to the women, they were still weak in faith and fearful of being arrested by the Jewish authorities.
