DEC. 10TH – THE SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"The baptism of repentance and purification in the Holy Spirit"

John the Baptist's life was fueled by one burning passion - to point others to Jesus Christ and to the coming of his kingdom. Who is John the Baptist and what is the significance of his message for our lives? Scripture tells us that John was *filled with the Holy Spirit even from his mother's womb* (Luke 1:15, 41) by Christ himself, whom Mary had just conceived by the Holy Spirit. When Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth, John leaped in her womb as they were filled with the Holy Spirit (Luke 1:41). The fire of the Spirit dwelt in John and made him the forerunner of the coming Messiah. John is one of those strong characters of the Advent season; not easy to forget in the mystery of Christ's coming, leading us to encounter! Question remains who are we leading to Christ? Who are we pointing toward salvation, fullness of life in Christ?

Advent preparation was significant last weekend, Saturday Dec. 2. Our Sacramental Preparation team led candidates for Confirmation and their parents for a half day retreat and "first" Eucharist candidates and their parents for an afternoon retreat. Parents reflected upon introduction to Alpha while the candidates celebrated the Dynamic Catholic series, *Decision point* themes for Confirmation candidates and *Blessed* program for "first" Eucharist candidates. One of the highlights was a 'take home' Advent wreath! This was a successful day for our monthly gathering of families celebrating the Easter Sacraments in the Spring. The month of May we will celebrate "first" Eucharist and May 22, at 7 pm. has been designated for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
