

December 4, 2022 – Second Sunday of Advent

<u>The second Sunday of Advent</u> gives us the opportunity to **prepare our hearts in faithful** waiting to celebrate the birth of Jesus and ready ourselves for his second coming. It's a beautiful chance to reflect on the ways prophecy has been fulfilled and to ponder what the future (promised to us through prophecies) will bring.
