# The Sacrament of Reconciliation in Advent Archbishop's Message – November 20, 2020

Inquiries have been made as to the possibility of celebrating communal penitential services in Advent, including the possibility of granting General Absolution. Both Archbishop Damphousse and I, are in agreement that this is not pastorally appropriate at this time. First of all, because it is risky for the health of those attending at a time when health restrictions will likely become stricter. Secondly, because this undermines the importance of individual contact in the celebration of sacraments, a key dimension of our life of faith. Thirdly, given the observation of the Holy See at the beginning of pandemic lockdowns that the faithful who are unable to access sacramental confession be encouraged to make a sincere act of contrition with the resolution to confess as soon as possible when conditions return to normal. Finally, priests are invited to make the Sacrament of Reconciliation available on a regular basis in the weeks leading up to Christmas.

In keeping with the above recommendations, the parish will not be having a separate Advent Penitential Service this year. For those who wish to avail themselves of the sacrament during Advent, individual confessions will be available prior to Mass every Saturday, from 3:00 p.m. to 4:15 p.m., and on weekday mornings; Monday to Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.


