## PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent – Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>


For all men and women being chosen by Christ to follow Him as priests, deacons, sisters and brothers, that they will persevere in the face of temptation against faithfulness to their call.
