SUPPORTING AGRICULTURE AND FOOD

SECURITY: While the world could feed its entire population, every day hundreds of millions of people go hungry. **Development and Peace** is working with farmers and peasant organisations in the Global South so that everyone can have access to food on a daily basis. In conjunction with local organizations, we are engaging policymakers to support small family farming, regulate trade in food, and promote input by and control of peasants over their products, means of production (land, seeds, etc.) and marketing. For example in the Democratic Republic of Congo, Development and Peace has supported the construction of public markets for Congolese women. In the eastern province of Katanga, working with our partners two public markets were established to benefit women who do business there, and to provide a way to market their agricultural produce. These markets are also providing a new form of citizen participation and democratic governance at the municipal level by promoting transparency as well as dialogue between citizens and local authorities. In Paraguay, **Development and Peace** is enabling our partner Decidamos to support small rural agricultural producers in Paraguay in their sustainable production of wholesome food. Several times a year, agroecology product fairs are organized for these farmers in Asunción, the country's capital. Due to support from Decidamos, farmers can get a fair price for their produce by selling directly to consumers. Your support and generosity through Share Lent donations and emergency appeals have enabled **Development** and Peace to promote justice and work to restore human dignity of those in the Global South.
