

From the Pastor's Desk

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time (Sun., Feb. 5th)

"You are the salt of the earth and light of the world"

Jesus used ordinary images, such as salt and light, to convey extraordinary truths that transform our minds, hearts, and lives. What does salt and light have to teach us about God and the transforming power of his kingdom? Salt was a valuable commodity in the ancient world. People traded with it, like we trade with valuable goods, such as gold and stock. Salt also served a very useful purpose, especially in warmer climates before the invention of electricity and refrigeration. Salt not only gave rich flavor to food, it also preserved food from going bad and being spoiled. Jesus used the image of light and a lamp to further his illustration of God's transforming work in and through us. This famous Gospel was the basis for Salt and Light TV, out of Toronto and the theme for WYD in 2002 in Toronto motivated many youth to become leaders for the New Evangelization. This Gospel also gives teaching and reflection on the Vocation of Marriage and Priesthood which I will be speaking on today!
