

PASTOR'S DESK

February 7th - Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed...He told them, 'Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come.' (Mark 1:35, 38)

In today's Gospel reading, we see a perfect example of stewardship. Jesus gives His time to do all that God wishes - healing the sick and preaching. But, before He begins, Jesus makes time to be alone with God in prayer. It is through prayer, spending time with God, that we find the strength to do what He wishes us to do. Be sure to find time every day to be with God.

Toward an understanding of the Sacraments: In Confirmation, God's mercy heals the fear that often accompanies being a public witness to the faith. How needed in our age is the merciful grace of confirmation to restore the Church's public witness, especially about the truth of the moral law. Let us pray for the adult candidates in RCIA, journeying toward the Easter Sacrament.

What does St Augustine say on Penance: St Augustine sees the Sacrament of Penance in the resurrection of Lazarus. Like Lazarus in the tomb, you also come forth when you make confession because what is coming forth but exiting a dark place? When you confess, God is calling you to come out to an abounding grace. And as the deceased came out still bound, you too go into confession bound by your guilt. For you to be free of your sins, the Lord says to his minister "Lose him, and let him go" (St Augustine, *Commentary on the Gospel* of St John, 49, 24).

A society is all the more human to the degree that it cares effectively for its most frail and suffering members, in a spirit of fraternal love. <u>Message from the</u> <u>Archbishop -</u> <u>Vaccination: Yes or No?</u>

For several weeks now, I have been receiving requests for clarification on the subject of vaccination. I have taken my time to answer these questions because it is a complex reality and it is important, in my position, to offer the faithful of our Diocesan Church statements that are truthful and clear. It is important to note that there is a lot of information circulating in social networks on this subject. Experts in the field of health seem to contradict each other on different aspects of the question. In addition, there are positions based on conspiracies, both political and religious. There is enough material in the media to confuse even the most learned.

My message today does not seek to enter the debate and argue one side or the other. I have, however, taken the time to consult with a few reputable, local Catholic doctors to shed some light on the situation and to help me formulate a directive that might unite us as a Church rather than divide us. I already see too many messages that sow fear and doubt and consequently division and judgment.

All things considered, I feel it is important to trust the messages of our public health authorities here in Canada and in Ontario. The main message is clear and it is based on a multitude of scientific sources using the most current information available.


