

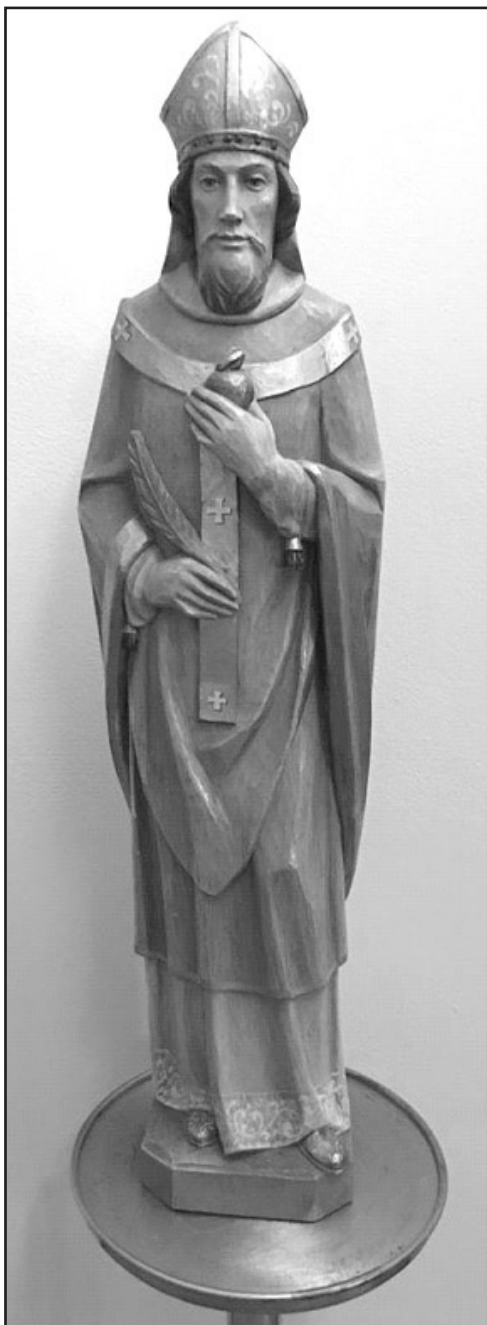

## February 9, 2020 – 5<sup>TH</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

***“Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.” (Matthew 5:16)***

***Some thoughts from our patron: The good shepherd feeds us with the words of God, by St. Augustine of Hippo, 354-430 A.D.*** "The pastures that this good shepherd has prepared for you, in which he has settled you for you to take your fill, are not various kinds of grasses and green things, among which some are sweet to the taste, some extremely bitter, which as the seasons succeed one another are sometimes there and sometimes not. Your pastures are the words of God and his commandments, and they have all been sown as sweet grasses. These pastures had been tasted by that man who said to God, 'How sweet are your words to my palate, more so than honey and the honeycomb in my mouth!' (Psalm 119:103)." 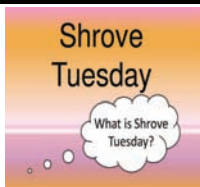
