From the Pastor's Desk

2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time (Sun., Jan. 15)

Ordinary Time is upon us until Wednesday, March 1 (Ash Wed.). These next several weeks are not ordinary by any means; the invitation for a deeper relationship to Christ and with Christ empowers us from the Gospel message. In his Apostolic Exhortation, *The Joy of the Gospel*, Pope Francis appeals to all of us to give ourselves to a "renewed personal encounter" with Jesus: I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since "no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord" [Paul VI, Apostolic Exhortation Gaudete in Dominol The Lord does not disappoint those who take this risk; whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that he is already there, waiting for us with open arms. [3] There are four elements to this invitation: 1) it is a renewal, 2) which is personal, 3) which is an encounter, 4) and it with Jesus.
