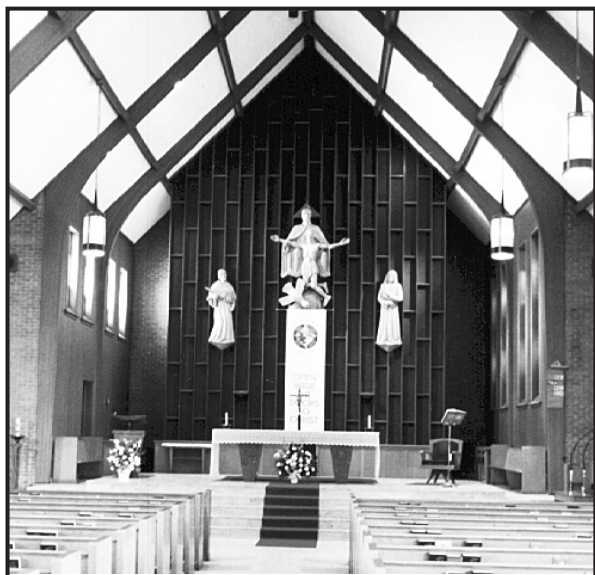

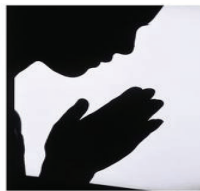

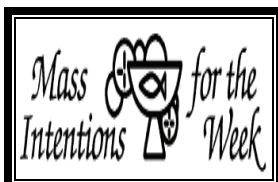

### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION TEAM

A Sacramental Preparation team is required for the Initiation Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. To respond to the Diocesan guidelines for Sacraments there is a need for facilitators to assist the pastor for adequate preparation for parents whose children are being prepared at Catholic school. One of the highlights of the year is for parents to partake of the Faith Formation sessions. Volunteers will need to assist the pastor at parent meetings, Rite of Enrolment (during Sunday mass) and the actual Sacrament celebrated in the Easter Season. ### VISITATION - FUNERALS

Visitation held in the church prior to the actual funeral mass is becoming a familiar time for bereaved families. Some parishes are providing time within the church for an hour or two for visitation prior to the funeral mass. With increased costs for funerals and meeting the guidelines set out by the Archdiocese, this is one way to facilitate inquiries about having it held at the church. My mother’s wake and funeral was held within the church in Nov. 2010, at St. Michael’s Church, Corkery; followed by burial.
