

### SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION TEAM

To respond to the Diocesan guidelines for Sacraments there is a need for facilitators to assist the pastor for adequate preparation for parents whose children are being prepared at Catholic school. One of the highlights of the year is for parents to partake of the Faith Formation sessions. Volunteers will need to assist the pastor at parent meetings, Rite of Enrolment (during Sunday mass) and the actual Sacrament celebrated in the Easter Season.
