This year 2024 marks the 200th anniversary of Corkery parish; its patron St Michael, located between Carp and Almonte. 200 years ago, this small Irish settlement came under the supervision of Kingston Diocese. In those days the priest went on 'horse/back' to offer the sacrifice of the Mass. There was originally a wooden church built in the now existing cemetery on Corkery Road (across from church) Eventually it burnt down and the under existing stone church built around 1860. Note the Archdiocese of Ottawa est. 1845. All of my ancestry Scott family came around 1840; when most Irish immigrants came out to the Ottawa area.

The Irish arrived in large numbers between 1817 and 1825 even before Ontario's internal routes had been built. Its good land, job prospects and climate made it the most popular destination. By 1850 Quebec and the Maritime provinces could no longer compete with it and increasingly lost their people to Ontario.

The Irish were particularly well concentrated in the Ottawa Valley which was the focal point of the region's timber trade. By 1881 people of Irish ancestry dominated 53 townships in an almost continuous line of settlements that straddled 8 counties.

## Recent discussion on Ashes Raises Concerns on the Diocesan Level:

A recent survey of Catholics showed that 48% agree that the resurrection of Jesus is a historical event. To delay the interment of ashes is reinforcing this lack of understanding.

- The Vatican said the ashes must be kept in "sacred places", and therefore neither at home, divided among family members nor scattered to the wind. One parish includes this document with their funeral information package.
- Cost maybe a factor for some people who choose no funeral home, just a company that offers cremation.
- Covid restrictions that limited funerals to 10 people has been a factor in some people delaying interment.
- Canadian bishops have issued a document to educate people about the treatment of ashes and that putting ashes in jewelry is not condoned by our faith.
- A concern has been raised that since Covid, people have delayed funerals with many waiting for weeks, or months. Often those delaying longer are further removed from an active Catholic faith.

#### **Sacramental Preparation:**

If you are an adult 18 years of age or older and are interested in pursuing the Sacraments, ie. Baptism, Confirmation and/or Eucharist, please get in touch with parish office. We are anticipating starting the program in September. Note, this program is ideal for those preparing for a wedding, or even for your children who are preparing for Sacraments as well.
