**PASTOR'S DESK****JUNE 18, 2023 – THE ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*“As you go, make this proclamation: ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’” Matthew 10:7*

Many of us take our lives for granted. We think we have plenty of time to “repent.” Maybe we should live with a little more urgency in making things right with God. This is the difference in living our discipleship out of obligation versus out of love. Obligation implies we do the minimum required. Love implies we want a relationship. God wants us to be with Him in Heaven forever, but He also wants to be in relationship with us right now, while we are on earth. Start this second – invite the Lord into your heart.

**Celebrating 70 years of parish life this year**, we look back on dates to remember especially after Vatican II had a dramatic effect on St Augustine parish through the 1960's. In September 1966, the communion railing was taken down, allowing the faithful to receive Holy Communion standing. At same time, the choir and organ console was brought down from the balcony, and a 36 foot-high wooden screen with cloth curtain was built behind the main altar (hide the organ pipes?) In March 1967, the new sanctuary and organ were blessed. Eventually in 1982, the Blessed Sacrament side altar was removed and relocated at the side alcove (where it is now), and the existing baptismal font was installed with warm running water.

**Looking ahead:**
