

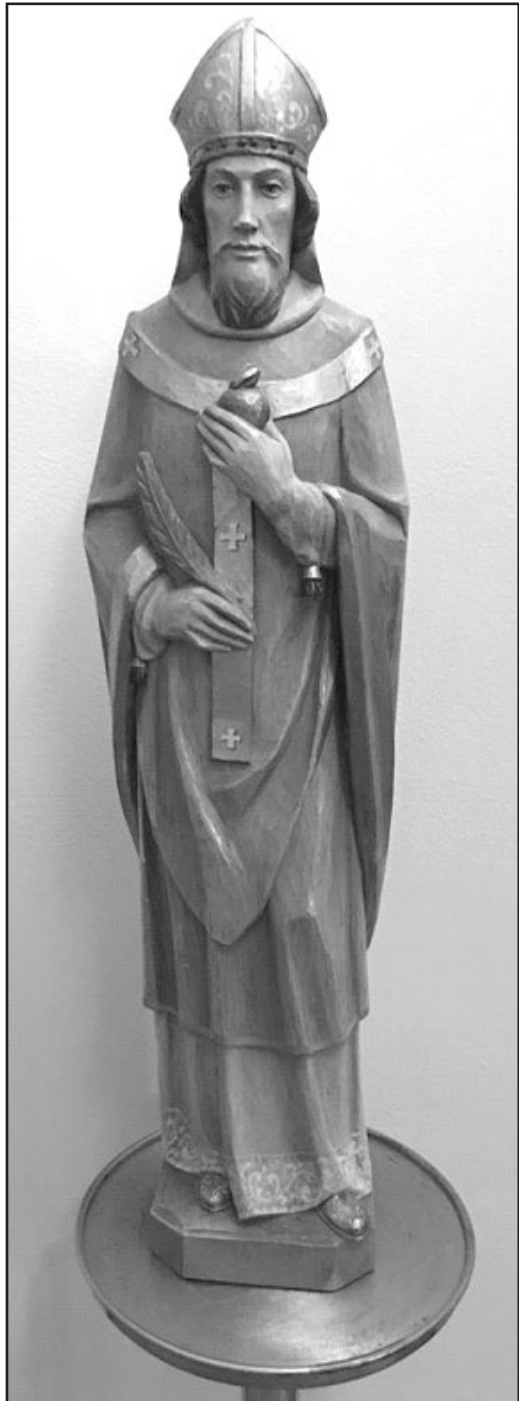

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Sunday, June 3rd)

"This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many"

Why did Jesus offer himself as "food and drink" to his disciples? Jesus chose the time of Passover to fulfill what he had announced earlier at Capernaum - giving his disciples his body and his blood (John 6:51-58). Jesus' passing over to his Father by his death and resurrection, the new Passover, is anticipated in the Last Supper and celebrated in the Eucharist or Lord's Supper, which fulfills the Jewish Passover and anticipates the final Passover of the church in the glory of God's kingdom.

*This special feast of Corpus Christi will highlight a 'special procession' around the church at end of Communion. Weather permitting, we will process around outside of church. (Note 9:00 Mass within church only).

REFUGE night of adoration and Praise of our God, in song, meditation and adoration of Blessed Sacrament; **Friday, June 15th, starting at 7:00 p.m.** This evening we highlight the experience of healing; prayer teams will be available for intercessory prayer and the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered by one of the priests present. *Come let us adore Him!*
