Tenth Sunday of Ordinary Time (C), June 5/16 "O Lord my God, I cried to you for help, and you have healed me" (Ps 30:2)

In this year of the Jubilee of Mercy, the Gospels come alive with the heart of God's message of love and compassion...Jesus heals her great loss, (widow) demonstrating God's mercy when he speaks the words, "Young man, I say to you, rise!" and the boy is alive.
