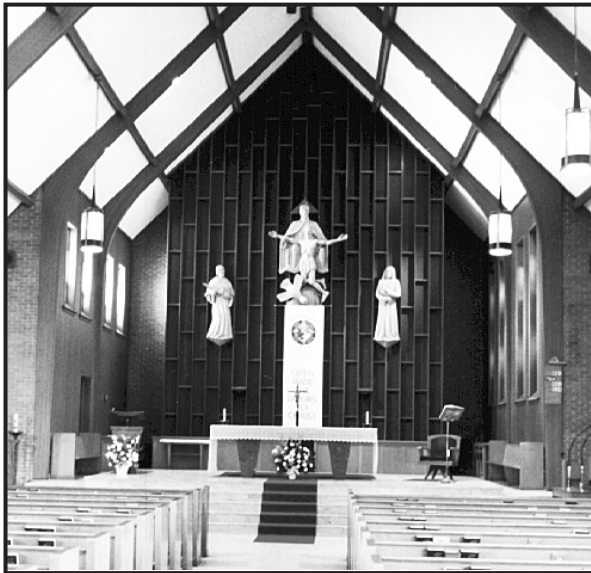

Tenth Sunday of Ordinary Time (C), June 5/16
“O Lord my God, I cried to you for help, and you have healed me” (Ps 30:2)

In this year of the Jubilee of Mercy, the Gospels come alive with the heart of God's message of love and compassion...Jesus heals her great loss, (widow) demonstrating God's mercy when he speaks the words, “Young man, I say to you, rise!” and the boy is alive. When Elijah's voice is heard by God, the widow of Zarephath's son arises. Elijah brings the child down to his mother and says, “See, your son is alive.”

Both of these cases indicate that mercy is at the heart of God's dealings with humanity, especially with those who have the greatest human need. It ought to be at the heart of our dealings with humanity as well. How are you experiencing God's mercy? What makes this year of Mercy special in your life and family?
