Gospel: **John 20.19-23**
As the Father has sent me, so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit.

**SEVEN THINGS YOU MAY NOT
KNOW ABOUT PENTECOST**

1. Pentecost does not fall on a set date each year but is always held between May 10 and June 13. This is because Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, which is not celebrated on a fixed date.
2. Pentecost is celebrated 50 days after Easter. The word Pentecost comes from the Greek word '**Pentekostos**', which means fiftieth.
3. Pentecost is also celebrated 10 days after the ascension of Jesus to heaven.
4. Pentecost is often called the 'birthday of the church' as it was the day the Holy Spirit entered the 12 apostles and is said to have been when the Church began. Speaking at the Holy Mass on the Solemnity of Pentecost on May 23, 2010, Pope Benedict XVI noted, 'There is no Church without Pentecost.'
5. Following Pentecost, the apostle Saint Peter (the first Pope) preached his first sermon and is said to have converted thousands of people, in what were the early beginnings of the Church.
6. Priests often wear red vestments on Pentecost. The red symbolizing the tongues of fire that came to the apostles at Pentecost and gave them the ability to speak and understand any language enabling them to spread the word of God.
7. Flames, wind, a dove and the breath of God are some of the symbols that are used to represent the Holy Spirit during Pentecost.

Archbishop of Ottawa-Cornwall Welcomes the Announcement of the Papal Visit to Canada: (On May 13) the Vatican officially announced that Pope Francis will travel to Canada from 24 to 29 July 2022 to meet with Indigenous Peoples of this land on a pilgrimage of healing, reconciliation, and hope. With this announcement, the Vatican confirmed the Holy Father will make three stops during his visit to Canada: Edmonton, Québec, and Iqaluit. These locations were chosen to limit travel for the Pope given his health, while still allowing for both intimate and public gatherings with Indigenous Peoples from everywhere in the country.
