**United Stewardship:**

***“If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.” - MARK 3:24***

Within your parish community, do your ministries of **Stewardship** collaborate with each other or do they compete against each other? Do your parish ministries work for the greater glory of God or do they work for the glory of the people running them? The primary goal of parish ministry is not to increase Mass attendance, increase the number of volunteers or increase offertory. The primary goal is to be one Body of Christ that helps people take one step closer to Jesus. If it's not doing that, it's not worth doing.

**Church news:**

*On May 23, Pope Francis **recognized a miracle** attributed to the intercession of Blessed Carlo Acutis, paving the way for him to become the first millennial saint.*

*The Italian computer-coding teenager who died of cancer in 2006 is known for his great devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. His witness inspired his own parents to return to practicing the Catholic faith and his Hindu au pair to convert and be baptized. What better way for Evangelization; a witness for the Graces of the Eucharist and a Saint for our youth of today.*

**A Pro-Life teaching:**

One of the world's biggest advocates for the abolition of the death penalty is the Catholic Church. In 1999, during his homily at a Mass in St Louis, Missouri, USA, Pope Saint John Paul II said "a sign of hope is the increasing recognition that the dignity of human life must never be taken away, even in the case of someone who has done great evil. I renew the appeal I made for a consensus to end the death penalty, which is both cruel and unnecessary". \*Vatican news May 30
