From the Pastor's Desk

March 10, 2019 – 1st Sunday of Lent

"I have now brought you the first fruits of the products of the soil which you, O Lord, have given to me." (Deuteronomy 26:10)

This line from the Old Testament offers two challenges. First, do you give to God from your "first fruits", the best that you have to offer, or do you give from what is leftover? Second, do you recognize that everything you have has been given to you by God? Ask God for a grateful and generous heart, every day, in all circumstances.

Our forty days of Lent is like a retreat ... We enter into the mystery unfolding! However, it doesn't end there ... we have 90 days of Lent - Easter. This is a time when spring is upon us in the days ahead. It's a great way of observing, entering into the mystery of the Death/Resurrection of Jesus, here at St. Augustine. You can join in the daily two-hour prayer experience. Church opens at 7:15 a.m. for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:30 a.m., Rosary at 8:30 a.m. and mass at 9:00 a.m. Each Saturday at 3:45 p.m., we will have the Stations of the Cross meditations. Our Communal Penitential Service will coincide with our monthly Refuge night, on **Friday, March 15, starting at 7:00 p.m.** There will be opportunity for individual confession. **Note**: Confessions also take place each Saturday from 3:30 p.m. to 4:15 p.m.

Is there more to life than this? This is one of the fundamental questions for the Alpha experience of 'faith renewal'. Do you have questions about your Faith, have doubts or questions? ALPHA is for you, commencing **Tuesday**, **March 26**th, **at 6:30 p.m. in the parish hall**. Come join us for food, formation, and fellowship. We all have a responsibility to engage, invite, encourage someone you might think of to be part of this 'life/changing' experience!

Cremation may have become the norm and decision for many people when it comes to responding to the death of a loved one. In my pastoral experience over the last (soon to be) 35 years; I have had fewer than expected number of respectful burial of ashes. Naturally this places healthy closure and respectful rite of burial for their loved one. Funeral directors will mention that they have a number of "unclaimed" urns that have to be stored back at the funeral home. Folks are often undecided or not near to bury their loved one at the cemetery. Church teaching is clear, scattering the cremated remains or keeping them in the home of family member does not exhibit appropriate reverence for the remains of the body which was the temple of the Holy Spirit.

Why this prayer! Pope Francis had requested this for the month of October. (Dedicated to the Rosary). Now Bishops of Ontario have requested this to be prayed at the end of mass. This prayer is for the church and the crisis that it is facing; in view of protection of minors, cover up, conversion of hearts and renewal.

St. Michael, the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the Devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.
