## From the Pastor's Desk

Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday) invites us to enter into the mystery that unfolds for us; do you identify being an observer in the crowd of the Gospel or do you easily identify with one of the characters of the Gospel? Using our imagination in this way "helps make the Gospel scene real and alive." As we begin this Holy Week, I invite you to join me in an imaginative journey through the two Gospel readings we hear proclaimed today. Focusing on our sense of sight, let us imagine what Jesus might have seen as he walked toward his Passion.

Notice at the start of the liturgy we are drawn into the entrance scene of Jerusalem and the crowds singing "hosanna to the son of David, the King of Israel" riding in on what? The foal of a donkey? Then we see and experience the liturgy change to the Passion according to Luke.... crowds eventually surround Jesus with "Crucify him... Crucify him" oh what drama... the liturgy then invites us to leave in "shared silence."

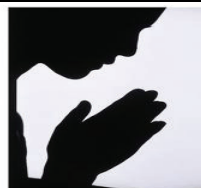
