JOINT CCCB-CCODP CAMPAIGN FOR EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS IN NEPAL

The Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher, Archbishop of Gatineau and President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, has announced a joint emergency campaign with the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace (CCODP) to raise funds for the victims of the earthquake in Nepal. In addition, the Government of Canada has announced it will match any contributions to assist Nepal which are collected by May 25, 2015. The Archdiocese of Ottawa has given an initial contribution to the relief efforts; however, all parishes are encouraged to provide further assistance. Envelopes marked "Nepal Earthquake Relief Fund" have been placed in the church pews for this collection. Please make your cheques payable to St. Augustine Parish. In order to meet the Government of Canada deadline, envelopes must be returned to the parish and placed in the Sunday collection basket no later than next weekend (May 16th/17th). The parish will send a lump sum cheque of the monies collected directly to CCODP - "Nepal Earthquake Relief Fund". Development and Peace is working in collaboration with the other Caritas members in the region, including Caritas Nepal, Caritas India, and the Catholic Relief Services office in India.
