**PASTOR'S DESK**


**May 23, 2021 – Pentecost Sunday**

*“There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone.” 1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-6*

All of us are blessed, regardless of our own individual circumstances. God has given each of us many gifts. How we use those gifts is our gift back to God. For God’s plan to work, each must do what we are called to do. Guess what? We are not all called to do the same thing! For God’s plan to work you have to do what God is calling you to do and I have to do what God is calling me to do. Happy Feast day to ALL parishioners; may this Pentecost empower us to share our gifts and talents!

**Sharing of our gifts and talents** will be a serious area to ponder, as we move more to post/pandemic times, whatever that may look like here at St. Augustine. Over the summer, I would invite to you to consider ways in which you could share your gifts or talents, your area of interest or expertise, in helping to build the Christian community. Would it be in the areas of hospitality, liturgy, social outreach? There are many areas where volunteers are a vital asset for parish life. What more favorable time than the fall to join a ministry or organization.

**Upon this rock I will build ...** One area of the church with a beautiful depiction of the Gospel is the Stations of the Cross. These were hand made by the artistic talent of Wilfrid Scharzkogler. The three-dimensional figures gracing the windows are hand carved and have raised title-lettering. The figures are freestanding and are set against a continuous flight of windows on each side of the nave. The windows, which form a backdrop for the stations are partitioned by wooden bars into sections with alternate glazed panes of off-white, light green and pale wine tone glass imported from Germany. Another contribution of Wilfrid's talent are all the bronze items in the church, designed and sculpted by him. I believe the last area was the Baptismal font; with an upper bowl shaped by three sides, along with a fountain and hot and cold water! We are still waiting for an immersion Baptism! You will also note that on the front part of the lectern both on top and below is the shield of St Augustine's coat of arms. The beautiful side chapel is dedicated for the Holy Eucharist; displays the tabernacle, door and cover; all made of bronze, as well as the candlestick/holders on the altar.
