

It was announced at the Vatican this morning (April 27), that Pope Francis has united the Diocese of Alexandria--Cornwall and the Archdiocese of Ottawa 'in the person of the bishop' [*in persona episcopi*]. Archbishop Prendergast is no longer the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall but now its Bishop. 
