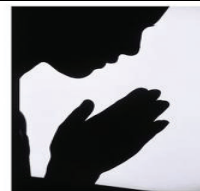

LAUNCH OF THE JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY IN THE ARCHDIOCESE AND OPENING OF THE DOOR OF MERCY AT NOTRE DAME CATHEDRAL BASILICA:

On **Dec. 8th**, Pope Francis will officially proclaim the opening of the **"Year of Mercy."** A Mass will be celebrated at Notre Dame Cathedral Basilica on **Tues., Dec. 8th, 7:30 p.m.** to mark the beginning of the Jubilee Year of Mercy. In Rome, the Door of Mercy will be opened on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Dec. 8th, for pilgrims to enter. Our Door of Mercy at Notre Dame Cathedral will open on **Sun., Dec. 13th, at the 9:00 a.m. Mass** (bilingual). Representatives of the many different faithful in Ottawa will make a symbolic entrance led by Archbishop Prendergast to inaugurate this special source of blessing. Our Door of Mercy will be the left front door of the Cathedral, the one closest to Guigues St. Introducing the Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis wrote: "it is indeed my wish that the Jubilee be a living experience of the closeness of the Father, whose tenderness is almost tangible, so that the faith of every believer may be strengthened and thus testimony to it be ever more effective". All are welcome to attend these celebrations at Notre Dame Cathedral.
