

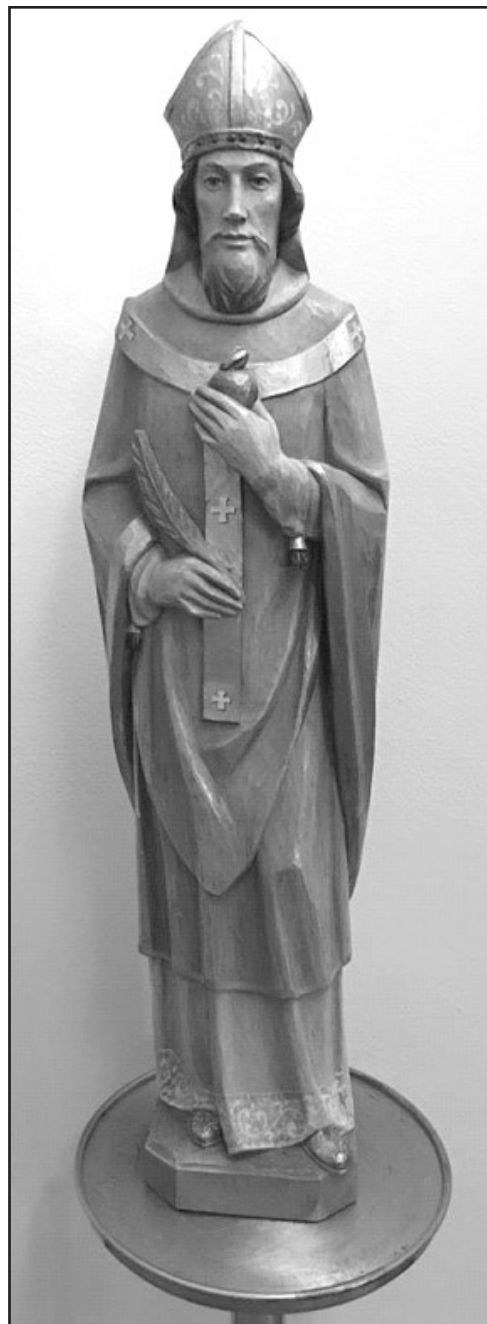

An **Advent Penance Service** is being planned for the **third Friday of the month, Friday, Dec. 21st, at 7 p.m., in conjunction with our monthly evening of REFUGE** (in thee O Lord I take refuge). Come let us adore Him ... priests will be available for individual confessions that evening, or if you prefer, confession is offered in our parish every Saturday evening at 3:30 p.m.

Who are you looking for? An evening of Vespers (evening prayer) with the Sisters of the Queenship of Mary, on the Third Sunday of Advent; **Sunday, Dec. 16th, at 7 p.m. (here in church)**. *Advent is THE time for beautiful evening liturgies, light, waiting, anticipation and expectation.*

Priest's Study week was held last week (Nov. 12-16), with its main theme on the New Evangelization; revitalizing parishes. All English speaking priests, were asked to attend and participate.
