

#### PASTOR'S DESK

### November 28, 2021- 1st Sunday of Advent

"But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand." (Luke 21:28)

We celebrate Advent each year in preparation for the birth of Jesus, His first coming, as we await His second coming. What will you do differently this Advent season to grow in friendship and love with Jesus? How will you inspire others to do the same? Start by sharing your God story with others, especially those who are closet to you. Invite and accompany them on their faith journey this Advent.

**Did you know?** Whether it has been a month or decades since our First Communion; it is good to remember that when we receive Christ in Communion, it should involve our whole person and all our senses. Cyril, a fourth-century patriarch of Jerusalem, gave great advice to the newly baptized on how to receive the sacrament: "In approaching therefore, come not with your wrists extended, or your fingers spread; but make your left hand a throne for the right, so as to receive a King." He then described how we are made holy by the touch of the sacred species on our hands and by looking at it with our eyes. He also talked about receiving from the cup: "Draw near also to the cup of his blood; not stretching forth your hands but bending and saying with an air of worship and reverence. Amen" The key is that Communion is something received by all of our senses.

**During Advent,** make time for prayer. In fact, google "praying Advent" and you will find a treasure trove of advice, counsel, and accompaniment that YOU do not want to miss. How are you preparing for "HIS coming?" **Why not encounter the Sacrament of Reconciliation?** During Advent the parish is offering the opportunity for confession on Saturdays (Dec. 11, 18, 24) beginning with a short prayer service at 3:00 p.m. and followed by confessions until 4:15 p.m. Confessions are also available before Mass, during the week (Monday to Thursday) – a priest will be available after the doors open at 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. This is a time of encounter with a Sacrament of JOY, a great theme for the Advent journey. *Come let us adore HIM!* 

Grateful for the beautiful evening at our Refuge last Friday night (Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>). The special theme was Remembrance, for all those who have gone before us marked with the sign of Faith. This special evening brought reflection and prayer to a special soldier who was gunned down at the Cenotaph a few years ago, Corp. Cirillo with a video of a moving eulogy by PM Harper. We also remembered all those loved ones who died this past year by reading out their names and lighting a candle in "remembrance". Thanks to Knights of Columbus and our music ministry for helping to make this event so special. About 60 faithful were in attendance. The next Refuge night of prayer is on Friday, Dec. 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. A special invite is extended to those who are journeying toward the Easter Sacraments (enrolment). (Fr Frank)
