"But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, 'Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I will give to the poor, and if I extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over.' "(Luke 19:8) We are all called to gratefully give back to the Lord in proportion to the blessings we have been given. This means everyone isn't called to give the same amount but is called to give equal sacrifice. No amount is too small or insignificant! Open your heart, how is God calling you to be more generous with your financial resources and possessions?

What are folks saying/believing in pews: According to a new Pew survey, 7 out of 10 people who identify as Catholic do not believe that the bread and wine "actually becomes" the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. Pew's survey also found that among Catholics who regularly attend Mass once a week, 63% know the Church's teaching; 14% flat out reject it; and 23% don't know. However, 75% of Catholics who attend monthly or yearly believe the Eucharist is just a symbol, and so do 87% of Catholics who seldom or never attend Mass.
