October 14, 2018 - Twenty Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

***"It is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."* MARK 10:25**

Jesus uses tough language that we may not want to hear. But, we are all called to be generous with all our gifts. Not just the ones we pick and choose, but all our gifts: our time in prayer to God, our talent in participating in parish ministries and our treasure supporting our local parish and other charities.

Beyond the hour on Sunday: We welcome our young people who are preparing for (first) Eucharist in the Easter Season. This past Wed evening, Oct. 3rd, we had the first meeting of families who have now registered their child. We are offering the program "**Come the Table**" in four sessions in the new year. It is imperative that parents/families partake of this wonderful catechesis, designed for families who are journeying in faith toward Easter. Klara Kinahan will offer this series she has designed at our parish. We will have an alternate session on Sunday, October 28th, here in the parish hall, for those who missed the session on Oct. 3rd. Confirmation candidates are encouraged to volunteer and be involved as greeters or servers at the 10:30 a.m. Mass each Sunday, sign up through your class at school.

Prayers go out to our closest neighbor, the Sisters of the Queenship of Mary, who have occupied the vacant building next door (former Ukrainian seminary). The sisters formally moved in on the feast of St. Francis of Assisi. (Oct. 4th). We are happy they will join us for liturgies and activities over the year. Let us especially remember the special synod in Rome, called forth by Pope Francis, for *Youth, Faith, and vocational discernment*. This major synod will highlight the presence of many youth, speakers and a renewed outreach to the youth of the world (Oct. 3-21). One of the highlights is the canonization of Pope Paul VI and Archbishop Oscar Romero.
