

OCT. 15TH – 28TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

The Gospel of Mathew for this Sunday continues to extol for us the how and why of the Kingdom...What can a royal wedding party tell us about God's kingdom? One of the most beautiful images used in the Scriptures to depict what heaven is like is the wedding celebration and royal feast given by the King for his newly-wed son and bride. Whatever grand feast we can imagine on earth, heaven is the feast of all feasts because the Lord of heaven and earth invites us to the most important banquet of all - not simply as bystanders or guests - but as members of Christ's own body, his bride the church! Having just celebrated Thanksgiving ... "What was the highlight for you?" This time of "giving Thanks."

More than a name ... Elizabeth Bruyere is familiar name around town. Did you know she is the foundress of the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa. Sr. Louise Charbonneau will give an overview of her foundress life and times here in Ottawa; around 1845. Mother Elizabeth Bruyere was very much part of the beginnings of Ottawa and establishing a hospital, orphanage and needed outreach in many ways. Her cause for Beatification has been ongoing, let us pray for her intercession!
