### OCTOBER 20, 2019 – TWENTY NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"...proclaim the word, be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient..." (2 Timothy 4:2)
It is not always convenient to be a good steward, especially when all the temptations of our busy and materialistic world get in the way. Now add our own pride and ego into the equation and living a stewardship lifestyle may be downright uncomfortable!

Remember. God didn't call us to be comfortable. He called us to be faithful.

**School Sacramental gatherings** will continue, on **Saturday Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup>**; at 3:00 p.m., downstairs in the parish hall. This session will be for candidates of (first) Eucharist and will focus on registration, intro and review of the calendar for the year. On Saturday Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>, candidates for Confirmation gathered to reflect on some teachings about Confirmation, Gifts of Holy Spirit, and expectations for the year leading up to this great Easter Sacrament in May 2020. As I mentioned at this meeting; the basics are non-negotiable family prayer, grace before meals, family rosary, "family that prays together stays together! Coming to church and partaking of the Children's Liturgy is a wonderful connection with parish life. Any children who are NOT baptized and wish to pursue Sacramental preparation must register and speak to the Pastor.

**Book of the Gospels** will be a new feature for Sunday Liturgy and feast days! You may have noticed already that we are bringing forth a special book in the procession at mass. This book is called the "Book of the Gospels"; it contains the Gospel of the day! Highlighting the prominence of the Gospel, its message and source and summit in our lives, will be/is common practice for the local and universal Church.
