

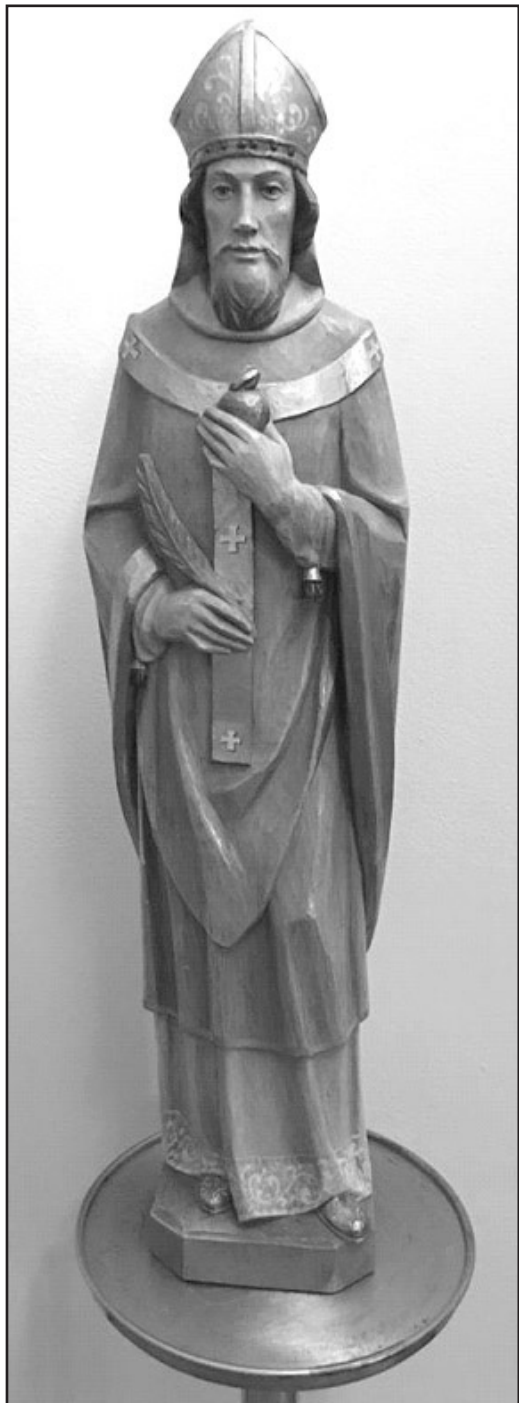

OCT. 29TH – 30TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

What is the greatest rule of life? God is love and everything he does flows from his love for us (1 John 3:1, 4:7-8, 16)

God puts us first in his thoughts and concerns - do we put him first in our thoughts? God loved us first (1 John 4:19) and our love for him is a response to his exceeding goodness and kindness towards us. The love of God comes first and the love of neighbor is firmly grounded in the love of God. The more we know of God's love, truth, and goodness, the more we love what he loves and reject whatever is hateful and contrary to his will. God commands us to love him first above all else - his love orients and directs our thoughts, intentions, and actions to what is wholly good and pleasing to him. He wants us to love him personally, wholeheartedly, and without any reservation or compromise.

The group will begin to ponder the Gospel of Mark; as we will soon launch into the Gospel of Mark for Sundays of the new Liturgical year, starting the first Sunday of Advent, Dec. 2!
