

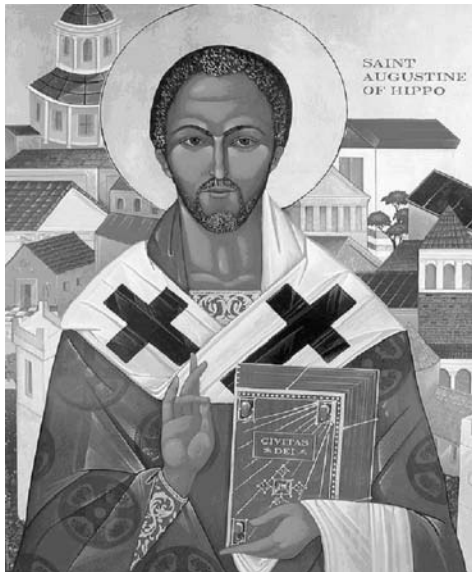

"Zacchaeus received Jesus joyfully"

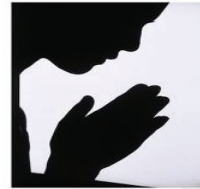

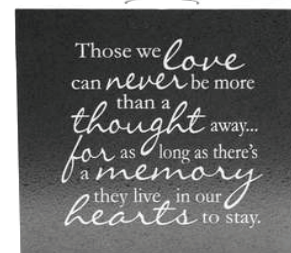
