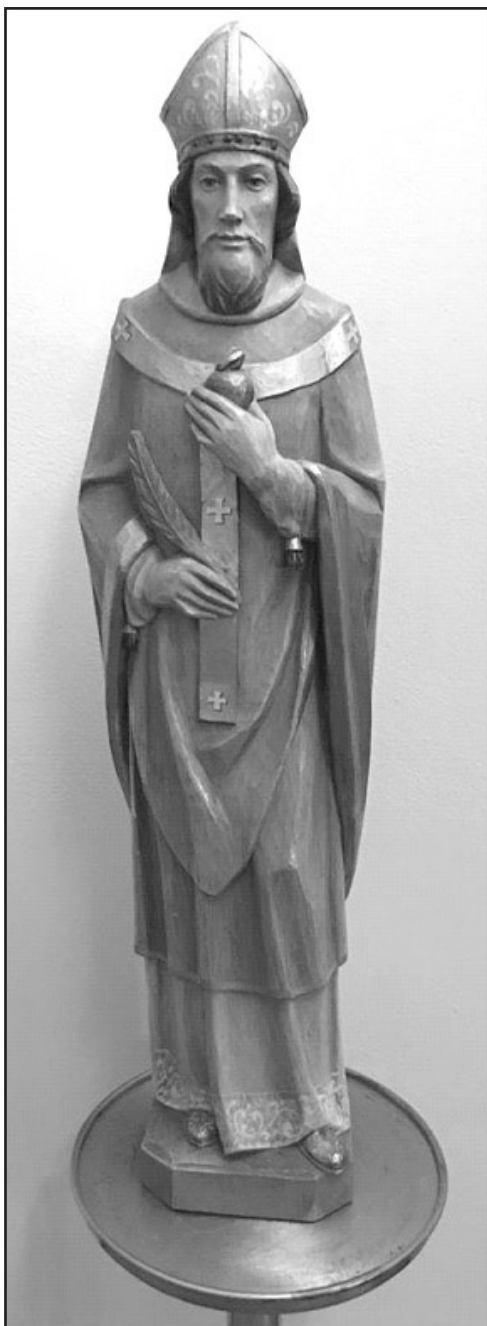

**Synod on Synodality is in full swing at the Vatican**

The Synod on Synodality, initiated by Pope Francis in October 2021, is a multiyear, worldwide undertaking during which Catholics were asked to submit feedback to their local dioceses on the question “What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our ‘journeying together?’”

The Catholic Church’s massive synodal process has already undergone diocesan, national, and continental stages. It will culminate in two global assemblies at the Vatican. The first will take place Oct. 4–28 and the second in October 2024 to advise the pope on the topic: “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission.” Where do you stand in light of this renewal and keeping alive the spirit of Vatican II?

I grew up not too far away from Windsor, Ontario, in the village of River Canard (Rivière-aux-Canards); the oldest of three children. We were all actively involved in the life of St. Joseph Parish. After high school, I completed an apprenticeship in the tool and mold industry as a machinist and mold maker, and during that time I began to grow in my faith and began discerning a call to the priesthood. Following my studies at St. Peter's Seminary, London, Ontario, I was ordained to the priesthood in April, 2010. Since that time, I have had the privilege of being associate pastor at St. Michael Parish, Leamington (2010-2015), director of vocations & seminarians for the Diocese of London (2015-2019), and pastor of the Windsor-Lake St. Clair Catholic Family of Parishes from 2019-2023.
