## Pastor's Corner

## SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 - TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you." (Luke 14:13-14)
We have a difficult time with the concept of giving without expecting something in return. Even when we give to charity we often want something in return - a raffle ticket, a dinner, a chance to play golf or our name in print. Yet, as Christian stewards, we need to remember that the true reward for our giving awaits us in heaven.

Deliver us Lord from all evil, part of the prayer of the Our Father. Let us not take it lightly in view of the Black Mass (invitation only) which took place on Saturday, Aug. $17^{\text {th }}$. My thoughts go back to May 14, 2014, when I was awoken to realize the tabernacle was taken out of the church at St. Martin de Porres Parish, (where I was pastor from 2009 to 2015), which fell victim to this diabolical act! Three vandals entered the church "in the night"... as we know "the thief comes when you least expect". Dark grafitti of Satanic ritual marked the altar cloth, anti-pope messages were on the walls of church, the parish hall was trashed, and the tabernacle was gone? The "unthinkable" happened!
