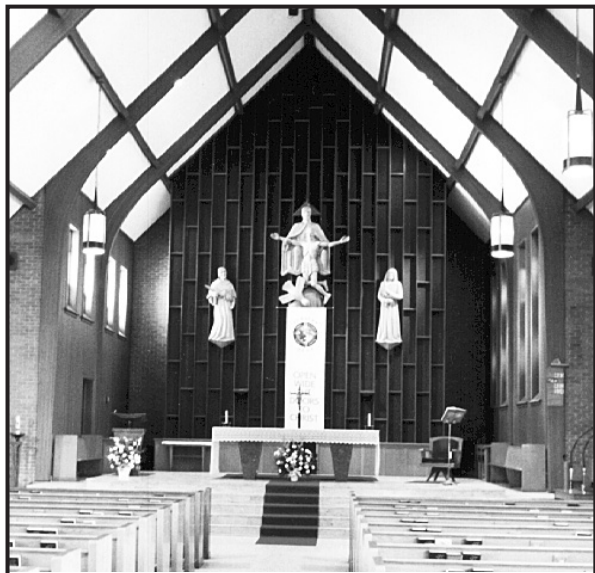

My child attends a public school ... If there are any inquires of parents whose children are in public school and wish to have preparation for (first) Eucharist and/or confirmation, they must contact parish office or email:

edda@st.augustineparish.ca and register for a "take home" package of materials. Important dates of meetings/gatherings and liturgies pertaining to these Sacraments will also be included in this package.
