

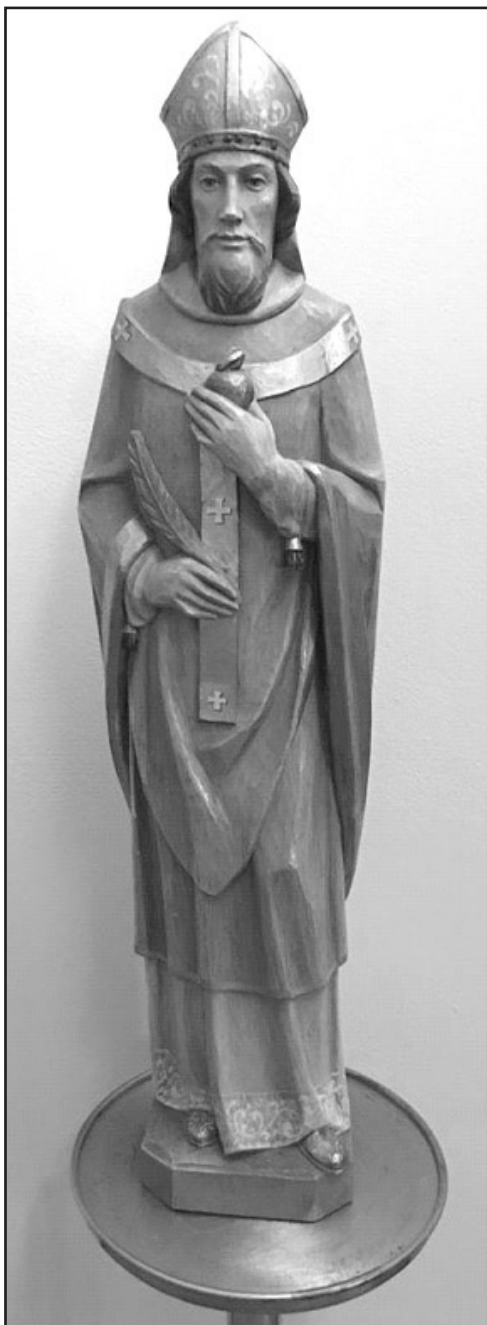

**September 13, 2020 – 24<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**NEWS FROM: THE ARCHBISHOP'S MESSAGE**

**September 3, 2020**

**Sacramental Celebrations**

We have received several inquiries regarding the celebration of the Sacraments of First Confession, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation that were cancelled due to Covid-19 restrictions. The resolution of these liturgical pressures on priests and parishes will need a bit more time. We encourage pastors to discuss with the schools and parishioners possible time lines for a return in safety to sacramental celebrations. Once it is clear how to proceed with small groups and limitations on family members who can be present, pastors may schedule small groups (preferably on week nights, Saturday mornings, or Sunday afternoons) when First Communion can be celebrated in safe conditions.

Archbishop Dampousse and I are consulting with other dioceses and bishops resident in Ottawa to consider what support we can offer you for Confirmations. We hope to retain that the link with the bishop is important by having a bishop or episcopal representative preside in at least some of the celebrations. We also feel it is important that we bishops be visibly present among the parishes in this very special time.

**Church Collections for Autumn 2020**

Several collections that would normally take place in the Lenten Season and before the end of the Pastoral Year were deferred due to Covid-19 restrictions. This means there's a larger number in the fall of this year. Here is the list of regular and re-scheduled collections:

**Sunday, 13 September 2020:** *Church in the Holy Land* (Rescheduled from Good Friday by the Holy Father).

**Sunday, 27 September 2020:** *Needs of the Church in Canada*

**Sunday, 4 October 2020:** *Pope's Pastoral Works* (Rescheduled from the Sixth Sunday of Easter by the Holy See)

**Sunday, 18 October 2020:** *World Mission Sunday*

**Sunday, November 15,** World Day of the Poor to benefit the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace-Caritas Canada (rescheduled by the Archdiocese from the Fifth Sunday of Lent)

Normally, the collection on World Day of the Poor would be for our relationship with the Hearst-Moosonee diocese. I have proposed to Bishop Bourgon that we present him with a fixed sum this year from our own diocesan resources and he has accepted this. There was a strong feeling that Development and Peace's collection should benefit from our appeal on World Day of the Poor.
