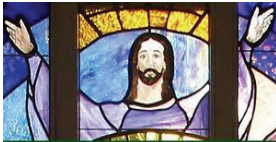
FRIDAY MORNING MASS

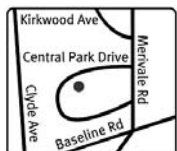
