

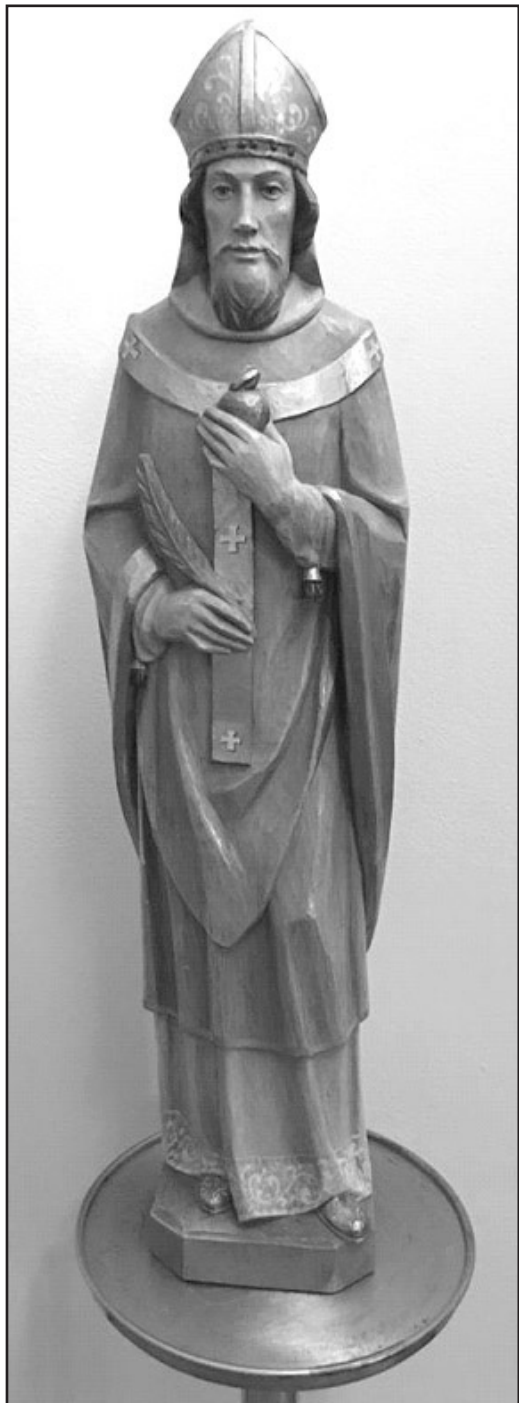

SEPT. 24TH – 25TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

"Do you begrudge my generosity?"

What can work and wages, welfare and the unemployed tell us about the kingdom of God? In the parable of the laborers in the vineyard we see the extraordinary generosity and compassion of God (Matthew 20:1-16). God is generous in opening the doors of his kingdom to all who will enter, both those who have labored a life-time for him and those who come at the last hour. While the reward is the same, the motive for one's labor can make all the difference. Some work only for reward. They will only put in as much effort as they think they will get back. Others labor out of love and joy for the opportunity to work and to serve others. The Lord Jesus calls each one of us to serve God and his kingdom with joy and zeal and to serve our neighbor with a generous spirit as well.

At the end of mass I was going down the aisle greeting folks as they were leaving and in through the front door of the church comes the delivery boy saying "hey Father here's your pizza!"
