SEPTEMBER 29, 2019 – TWENTY SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"My child, remember that you received what was good during your lifetime while Lazarus likewise received what was bad; but now he is comforted here, whereas you are tormented. Moreover, between us and you a great chasm is established..." (Luke 16:25-26)

When God created the world, He declared that it was good and He gave it to all mankind for us to enjoy. However, over the years we have created a chasm between those who have great gifts and those who do not. In today's Gospel we see that with our own generosity we must bridge that gap between those who have much and those who have little or we may find ourselves on the wrong side of the chasm in the next life.

Initiation Sacraments: First parent/child meeting to be held **Saturday**, **Oct.** 5th, at 3 pm in parish hall. Those who desire to register and partake of these monthly sessions; are asked to be present. Any candidate who is not baptized needs to call the parish office. After speaking to a couple of pastors, it seems that First Eucharist or Confirmation is now at about 50% response of a class and/or baptized believer! I am particularly worried about why/how so few parents partake of Sunday Mass? (Fr Frank)

Are you on board? Prayers requested: The upcoming Synod of Bishops on the Amazon will challenge Canada regarding its own relationship with Indigenous peoples and the environment, said Archbishop Donald Bolen of Regina. (Catholic register Sept. 18) "I've come to realize we have much to learn from Indigenous peoples on living on the land in a healthy and sustainable way," the archbishop said. A major focus of the Oct. 6-27 Amazon synod will be recasting the mission of the Church in a vast region that wrestles with complex political, cultural, ecological and pastoral issues, and where Indigenous people must cope with historical injustice and ongoing threats to their way of life. Many of the themes relate directly to Canada in terms of respecting the natural environment and native cultures, forging new relationships founded on dignity and respect and bringing the sacraments to remote regions.

Beyond the Hour on Sunday: Where are we as a parish? What are some of the characteristics of our current parish culture? More important, where are we going? What are the characteristics of a parish culture that makes disciples? There are studies, programs, vision statements and missions speaking of how a parish needs to move from being a maintenance-driven community to being a mission-oriented community. Here, at St. Augustine parish; I believe there is great concentration on just "attending mass on Sunday" nothing else! There are many programs on during the week, daily mass, two Bible studies, Knights of Columbus, all invitations to get involved. Isn't there more to parish life than this?


